



TAKING MEN'S MEASUREMENTS

COAT MEASURES

Take these measures over a shirt

The tape should be horizontal to the floor when taking circumference measurements

A - B—Chest -Over the prominent part of shoulder blades and chest.

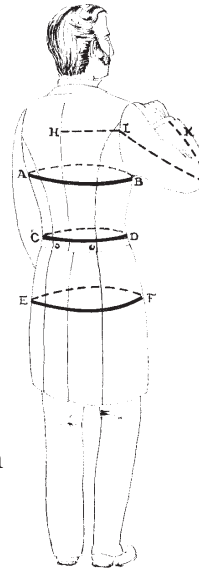
C - D—Coat Waist - Over the prominent point of waist.

E - F—Hip -Over most prominent point of hip.

Take these measures with a coat on.

H - I—Half Back Width- From center back seam, at shoulder blade level, to sleeve seam.

I - K—Sleeve Length - Bending the arm, continue from the sleeve seam, along elbow seam of sleeve, to the hollow beyond the wrist bone.



TROUSER MEASURES

A - B—Waist -At the top of the hip bone.

C - D—Hip -Taken over most prominent point of hip.

To be taken without shoes

E - F—Oustside Leg - From the top of the hip bone to the floor.

G - F—Inside Leg - From the crotch point to the floor.

G - I—Inside Leg to Knee - From the crotch point to the crease in the knee when bent.
